FLEET POLICY

STREET DEPARTMENT (see updated Street Department Fleet Policy adopted August 22, 2006)

EQUIPMENT REPLACED EVERY 6 YEARS:

Brush Chipper
Gyro Mower
Ditch Mower

EQUIPMENT REPLACED EVERY 10 YEARS:

One-ton Dump Trucks
Pickup Trucks
Front Bucket End Loader
Street Sweeper
Leaf Vacuum Unit

EQUIPMENT REPLACED EVERY 15 YEARS:

33,000 G.V.W. Dump Trucks with Plows, Wings and Spreaders (start diesel purchases in 2007 per Public Works Committee)
Buck Backhoe Digger (check with Utilities for duplications)
Asphalt Roller/Vibrator (check with Utilities for duplications)
Tractors 45 Hp to 65 Hp

EQUIPMENT REPLACED EVERY 20 YEARS:

Leaf Vacuums (cab and chassis)
Motor Grader
Loader Mount Snow-Blower

EQUIPMENT REPLACED OTHER:

Bucket Truck, trade on Utilities Schedule
Front Bucket Skidder, replace every year on program setup with vendor

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Squad Cars: replaced every 2-3 years and prior to 80,000 miles.

EMS DEPARTMENT

Ambulances are replaced on a 10-year cycle. A newly purchased ambulance is placed as the primary ambulance until a 5-year period has expired. This ambulance is placed as the secondary ambulance for another 5-year period. The secondary ambulance is then replaced with a new style ambulance and is placed as the primary ambulance for the next 5 years.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

A well planned age based replacement program using the NFPA as a guideline.
