The following is a press release authorized by the Dane County Sheriff's Office. A Core Team evaluates and makes decisions on the level of notification to the community for the release of sex offenders under Wisconsin Statutes 301.45 and 301.46.

The Core Team will be holding a Community Notification meeting on June 26, 2014 at 6:30 PM. This meeting will be held at the Stoughton Fire Department – Training Room at 401 E. Main St., Stoughton, Wisconsin. At this meeting we will be offering information about the Community Notification Law and the release of Alfred Riley.

A photo of Alfred Riley will be available at this meeting, as well as more detailed information regarding his offenses. Information about protective behaviors and personal safety in our community will also be discussed.

The Core Team is encouraging the citizens of the Town of Dunkirk and the City of Stoughton to attend this meeting to gain knowledge about this offender, the sex offender registry and protective behaviors.

SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION BULLETIN

June 19, 2014

The Dane County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.46(2m) which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when; in the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety, awareness and protection. The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense. Further, his criminal history places him in a classification level, which reflects the potential to re-offend.

This offender has served the incarceration sentence imposed on him by the courts. **He is NOT wanted by the police at this time.** *This notification is not intended to increase fear, rather, it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public.*

Sex offenders **have always** lived in our communities; but it was not until Act 440 was enacted that law enforcement is able to share this information with the community. **Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will NOT be tolerated.**

Alfred Riley has a conviction in 1987 for 3 counts of 2nd Degree Sexual Assault and another conviction in 1987 for 2nd Degree Sexual Assault. **Riley** was civilly committed in 2001 under Wisconsin Statute 980. **Riley** was granted a supervised release in May 2014 to live in the Town of Dunkirk.

Alfred Riley will be residing in the Town of Dunkirk at 683 USH 51. **Riley** is a lifetime registrant of the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registration Program.

Additional Sex Offender Information:

As of the date of this bulletin, there are over 20,000 sex offenders who have registered as required in the State of Wisconsin. There are over 5,000 sex offenders on probation or parole throughout the State. Approximately 625 of these are registered to Dane County Addresses.
