Normal Burning Procedures in Effect

Areas covered by the Stoughton Fire Department are now back to “normal” open burn procedures, effective today, May 1, 2020.

City of Stoughton residents can only use UL approved devices for small cooking type fires and campfires. There is no burning of leaves, garbage or recyclables.

Residents in the Towns of Dunn, Dunkirk, Rutland and Pleasant Springs, need to follow the regulations for permitted burning in those areas. We request you make contact with the Stoughton Fire Station at 608-873-7218 so we have knowledge of any planned burning.

Please be aware of changing weather conditions, high winds, and other dangers if you are thinking about burning. If a fire gets out of control, please call 911 immediately.
