*This year's street projects include:*

- Lowell Street – Page St. to Monroe St. – Full Reconstruction (including curb & gutter and driveway aprons) with spot sidewalk replacement and install sidewalk on north side of street. Underground utility improvements will be part of this project.
- S. Monroe St. – Lowell St. to Patterson St. – Full Reconstruction (including curb & gutter and driveway aprons) with spot sidewalk replacement and infill missing sidewalk segment. Underground utility improvements will be part of this project. Traffic calming features are being planned for this project.
- Patterson St. – Monroe St. to Harrison St. – Full Reconstruction (including curb & gutter and driveway aprons) with spot sidewalk replacement and install sidewalks on south side of street. Underground utility improvements will be part of this project.
- Jackson St. – S. Van Buren St. to Kings Lynn Rd. – Pulverization with spot curb and gutter replacement, spot apron replacement, spot sidewalk replacement and infill missing sidewalk on south side of street. Traffic calming features are being planned for this project.

- Lincoln Avenue – Jackson St. north to 1212 Lincoln Ave. - Pulverization with spot curb and gutter replacement, spot apron replacement, spot sidewalk replacement. Storm sewer work is part of this project. Traffic calming features are being planned for this project.
