

RULES OF BEHAVIOR AND DISCIPLINE RECREATION DEPARTMENT

Participants and fans have the right to not be physically threatened, verbally threatened or harassed. The goal is “to protect everyone’s right to enjoy, participate, attend, and view, without the fear of unacceptable behavior and harm.”

Infractions of the rules will be handled by the Parks and Recreation Director.

A person has a right to appeal a disciplinary action that calls for life-long or multi-year bans from attending or participating in a program. A person will be required to file a request in writing and the Recreation Director will be required to compile the facts for review by the Council Community Affairs Committee. The person charged with infraction will have the right to present facts to the committees. Suspension, if applied, will be in effect until the appeal process has been completed.

If a state law is violated, criminal charges could be filed against the persons responsible.
